SAVING LIVES

THROUGH AFFORDABLE HEARTWORM TREATMENTS

"If you weren't here I couldn't have afforded to get Ben the health care he desperately needs."

After Allison adopted Ben, his first veterinary exam revealed he was heartworm positive. Allison was relieved to learn that Emancipet could provide Ben's heartworm treatment injections for a fraction of the cost compared to for-profit vet hospitals, and in her words "saved the day!"

Heartworm treatment is a multi-step process and takes about a year to complete. Ben completed the doxycycline initial treatment, and according to Allison is taking his heartworm preventative like a champ! Allison is happy to share that Ben is doing great, he is gentle, friendly and gets along with everyone in the neighborhood including Allison's cat and other dog.

Heartworm disease is very serious, however when treated early, a pet's chance at survival is high. Currently, there is effective treatment available for dogs with heartworm disease, and Emancipet offers these services at our Norwood Park (Austin) and Wayside Drive (Houston) clinics, as well as low-cost preventative medicine and testing at all of our clinics. Heartworm disease will cause severe damage to your dog's heart and lungs and if left untreated, and will eventually lead to death. Emancipet follows the American Heartworm Society's recommendations for treatment of heartworm disease, which will safely kill adult and immature heartworms.

We are very proud that our veterinarians provided 3,704 life-saving heartworm treatments during 2022 — Including Ben's — while contributing to the body of knowledge about this treatment.
