Who is Emancipet?



Emancipet is a non-profit organization that operates low-cost veterinary clinics in neighborhoods across the country to ensure all pet families in need have access to affordable veterinary care for their pets.

We believe that every pet needs and deserves high-quality veterinary care to keep them healthy and happy for their entire lives. But we know that sometimes a visit to the vet is financially out of reach for some families, and inaccessible in some communities. We're here to change that.

Access to Veterinary Care

Why is our work needed?



In the US, veterinary care is almost entirely provided by the market sector.

However, the market sector cannot meet all the needs of people at every income level.

So, millions of pet owners are excluded from accessing this care.

A non-profit model is needed to ensure **EVERYONE** has access to care.

Today, there are 60 million beloved pets across the country whose families cannot access or afford veterinary care. **We are changing that.**

Meet Rodeo

Rodeo was born with a congenital defect, leaving her front right leg without a limb below the elbow. Her remaining front leg was often scabbed and bleeding. Dustin, wanting the best for Rodeo, was referred to Emancipet for affordable treatment.

At our Austin Dental and Surgical Center, expert veterinarians decided an amputation was necessary. On the first day of operations, Dr. Clapham successfully performed Rodeo's surgery.

What Do We Do?

All Emancipet clinics provide veterinary care at deeply reduced prices, making it possible for more families to afford the care their pets need.



1 out of 4 pet-owning households experience financial barriers to accessing veterinary care.



Low-income families face more barriers than others. Historically marginalized communities have faced even more challenges,

making it harder to meet the needs of the entire family, including pets.



Emancipet clinics are located in neighborhoods where families are low income, and where there have been few, if any, market

sector veterinary clinics, so we are bringing care to the neighborhood.



While most of our clients pay for services, we price all procedures as low as possible - below our cost to provide care - AND no pet owner is

turned away for an inability to pay at any of our clinics.

This is only possible because of our donors, who cover a portion of our true cost on every single service we provide, and because of our efficient, high-volume operating model, which keeps our costs low.

Our clients pay 70% of our costs and our donors cover the remaining 30%.

Healthy Pet Services

Checkups, vaccines/shots, microchips, flea/tick preventative, and more.

Spay & Neuter

Low-cost surgeries for dogs and cats.

Heartworm Treatment

Low-cost, comprehensive heartworm treatment for dogs.

Surgeries

Low-cost surgical procedures for conditions that compromise the health and comfort of your pet.

Dental Services

Cleaning and treatment for any dog or cat with dental disease.

Urgent Care

Urgent or emergency treatment of pyometra or dystocia surgeries for female dogs or cats.

Training and Consulting Services

Emancipet New School has trained over 278 organizations spread across 3 countries and 42 states to provide accessible care in their own communities.

Leader in Innovation

Emancipet has created and is working on new models to share out with the field including the first-of-its-kind high volume, low-cost Dental and Surgical Center in Austin, Texas.

Transformative Partnerships

Emancipet in Houston



At the urging of BARC leadership and several members of the Houston City Council, including Robert Gallegos and Ed Gonzelez, and then-mayor Annise Parker, Emancipet decided to come to Houston.

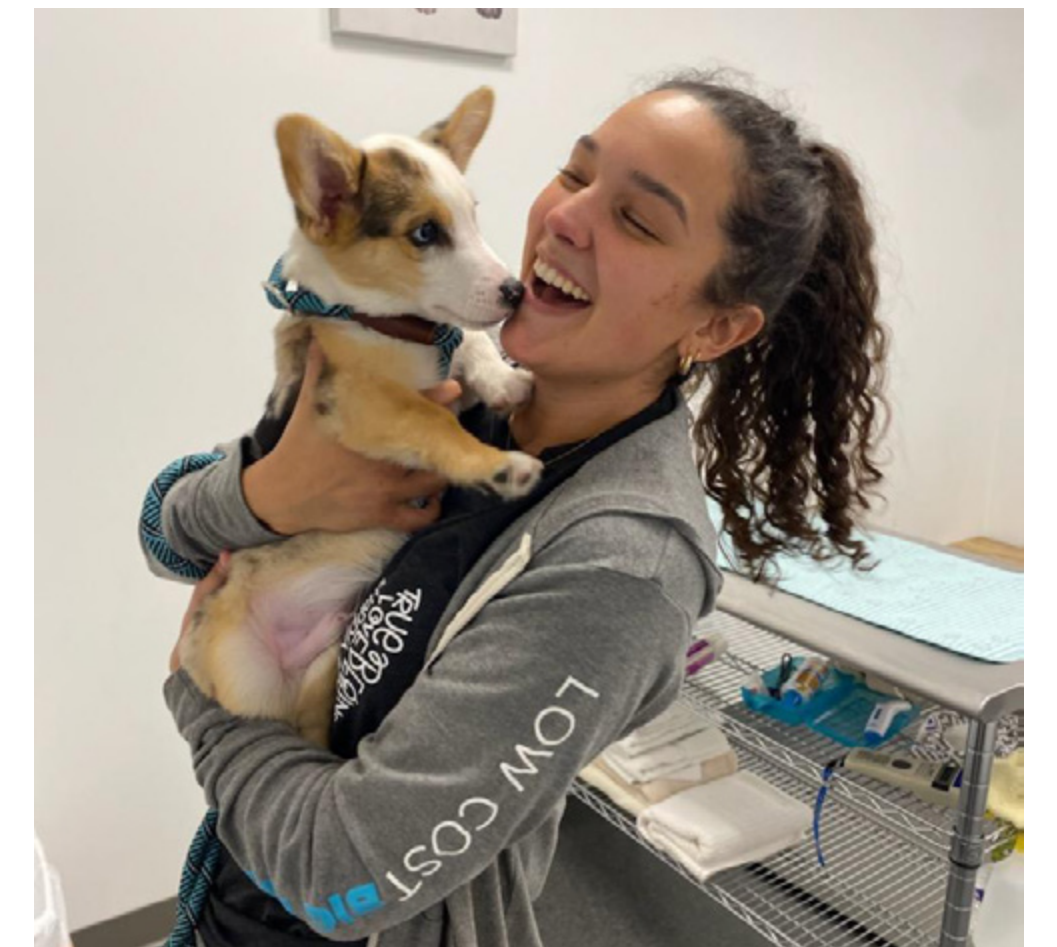
Emancipet offers life-saving heartworm treatment at both the Wayside Drive and Monroe Plaza clinic locations.

Our Northwest Freeway clinic opened in 2022, located inside the PetSmart retail store.

Growing year over year, Emancipet Houston saw 5,177 visits in 2015, and saw over 74,000 visits in 2025.

Emancipet in Philadelphia



At the request of the Humane Society of the United States and PetSmart Charities, Emancipet expanded outside of Texas to Philadelphia, Pennsylvania in 2017.

There are more than 573,000 pets living with Philadelphia families who love them, but can't always afford veterinary care.



Emancipet opened its first clinic on Adams Ave, in northeast Philadelphia in 2017.



Our Roosevelt Blvd clinic opened in 2022, located inside the PetSmart retail store.

DID YOU KNOW?

Starting in late 2025, Emancipet began offering online booking and appointments for our Healthy Pet Services and spay/neuter surgeries in Philadelphia, increasing access to care for our communities.

Growing year over year, Emancipet Philadelphia saw 4,802 visits in 2017, and over 49,000 visits in 2025.

Emancipet in Central TX

There are more than 300,000 pets living with Central Texas families who love them, but can't always afford veterinary care.

DID YOU KNOW?

Austin continues to be our headquarters and home of innovation in the access to care field.

Emancipet, founded in Austin, Texas in 1999, began by performing spay/neuter surgeries in a mobile unit and has since grown to include clinics in Austin, Pflugerville, Killeen, and our newest clinic, the Austin Dental and Surgical Center.

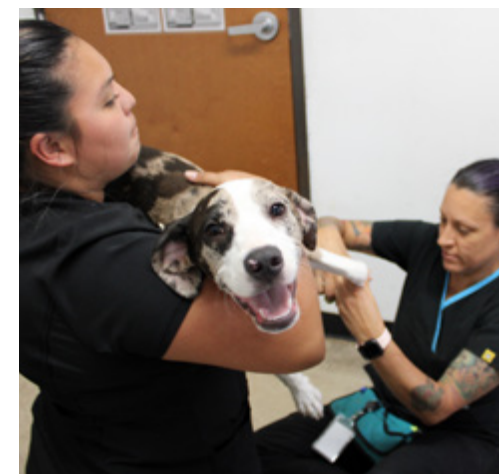
As part of our commitment to accessible veterinary care, in 2025, Emancipet relaunched our Central Texas Regional Low Cost Mobile Spay/Neuter Clinic, offering low-cost, appointment-based spay/neuter surgeries for pet families in areas surrounding Travis County, including locations Burnet, Guadalupe, Williamson, Hays, Bastrop and Caldwell Counties.



Mobile Clinic

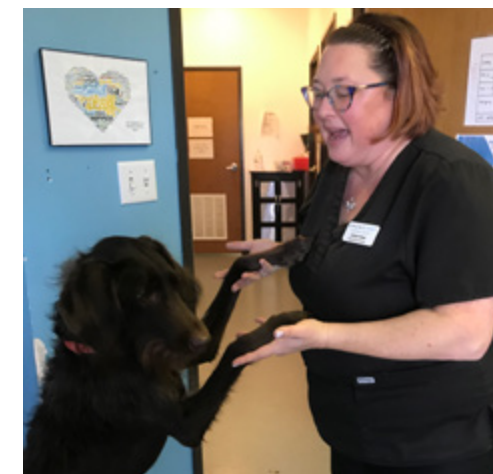

Our Austin mobile veterinary clinic offers free or discounted services for pets who live in the City of Austin or Travis County.



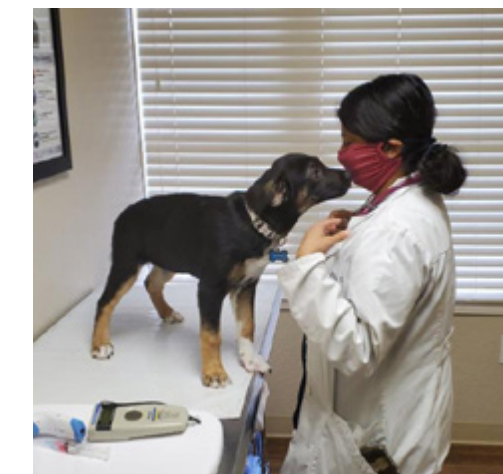

01

Safe

We ensure the care we provide to help patients does not cause harm.

02

Effective

We base our services on scientific knowledge to provide patients with all the services they need and none of the services they don't.

03

Efficient

We use our resources wisely, minimizing waste to maximize our impact.

04

Patient Centered

We center the medical needs of our patients while respecting and being guided by the values, preferences, and circumstances of their families (owners).

05

Equitable

We provide patients with care that does not vary in quality because of the personal characteristics, identities, or financial circumstances of their families (owners).

06

Timely

We work to avoid harmful delays in care and reduce wait times for services.



Building the Access to Care Field

As one of the early players in this space, Emancipet works to build the field through training and consulting, publishing research that helps other clinics integrate lower-cost veterinary protocols, and with thought leadership by sharing information about our operations and systems - including innovative financial and business models - with others.

Emancipet New School

Emancipet New School is a training program that has offered seminars, consulting, resources, and support to animal welfare professionals since 2013.

Research at Emancipet

Research at Emancipet aims to share insights on how we achieve broad access to care, and to continually refine our operational and medical processes. Our first published research, surrounding Heartworm Treatment, was published earlier this year.
